• AMC Updates from Charlie and Meighan

Charlie shared what he could about the board retreat and the 76 AMC staff run properties that were reviewed. Noble View will become a trails south hub instead of an overnight facility from April to November, as trail crews will be housed there for the summer. The cabins can be rented in the winter. Cardigan and Mohegan will be self-service in the winter months. Financial issues remain, but AMC is \$32,000 ahead of where they expected to be. Lodging is up

5%. Look for some changes, including per bed pricing

Outdoors Connector launch date and details to be shared in the next volunteer newsletter.

Expected to be online the first week in December with some tiered training for us.

Meighan shared about some accidental/bogus emails that went out to actual participants.

Chapter Reimagining defined by Charlie and Meighan. There is a sub committee that meets that will be making recommendations. Nicole wants it to be chapter led initiatives that solve problems that chapters are experiencing by potentially restructuring. Steve C and Wendy are on the sub committee.

Ingrid asked how the gear shed will continue to be supported by staff and Worcester. Meighan shared that gear sheds in general are a strategic priority and the club wants to replicate what we have started. She's going to reach out to Colby Meehan for an update. For now, it's the Worcester Gear Shed and we should consider a management plan.

Rob asked for specific guidelines for partnering with other organizations and access excess reserves. Meighan asked to add it as an agenda item at our next meeting. Charlie reminded us that documents do exist to guide us. Mike P continues to question and voice his displeasure about the Worcester Chapter no longer having the ability to directly issue grants from the endowment to partners of our own choosing.
